(1/2)

- Economic situation in general and especially of forest industry very challenging in Finland; taking this into account our financial results were relatively good
- Profit 59 mill. Euros (95 % dividend to the State)
- Cuttings about 4.7 mill.m3
- Increase in wood energy delivery
- Difficult year in nature tourism and soil resources businesses

Metsähallitus in 2009

(2/2)

- New cutting restrictions on more than 40.000 ha forest land
- New large scale natural resource plans: inceasing the cutting budget while at the same time giving more emphasis on multipleuse objectives
- Continuous increase in productivity at Natural Heritage Services
- New figures about the significancy of national parks on regional and local economies: economic effects in the society are much higher than the State money used on the services and infrastructure
- ? Destiny of the Finnish State Enterprise Model ?
